




In 2010 Delta-Q Technologies needed a training solution that would meet their ISO certification requirements. Forseng Consulting designed and delivered 27 eLearning modules on production processes and integrated them into Delta-Q's existing employee SharePoint portal.




In 2010 the BC Early Hearing Program designed a new SharePoint-based portal to serve the needs of both practitioners and families throughout the province. Forseng Consulting created a series of 11 narrated and captioned instructional videos to aid users in finding and consuming information located on the portal.




In 2009 and 2010 the Provincial Health Services Authority had to deliver MS SharePoint user and administrator training that would serve as the primary application instruction for a geographically dispersed audience. Forseng Consulting designed, developed eLearning to meet that need.

In 2008 BC Mental Health and Addiction Services had to deliver Clinical Documentation Training to nursing staff with reduced instructional, classroom, and travel resources. Forseng Consulting developed eLearning that met the need within the constraints.



In 2007 the Provincial Health Services Authority implemented the SumTotal learning management system. Forseng Consulting provided implementation support and curriculum design services. The learning management system now serves over 10,000 learners across British Columbia.
